## Elementary Art Show (February 20 - March 7, 2026)

- Open to grades K to 6 only\*
- Drop-off dates: Monday, Feb. 9 Friday, Feb. 13 (Annex, 10:00am-4:00pm) & Saturday, Feb. 14 (Annex, 12:00pm-4:00pm)
- Exhibition dates: February 20 March 7, 2026
- Opening celebration: Friday, February 20 from 4pm-6pm

## Middle/High School Juried Art Show (March 13 - April 4, 2026)

The high school show is for grades 6-12\* only. However, grades 6, 7, 8 & 9 will be juried as one group and 10, 11 & 12 will be juried as another group. They will be juried and awarded separately but will be hung as one cohesive show. Not all pieces are accepted. <u>Middle/High School works must be professionally presented and ready to hang</u>.

- Drop-off dates: Monday, March 2 Friday, March 6 (Annex, 10:00am-4:00pm) & Saturday March 7 (Annex, 12:00pm-4:00pm)
- Jurying: March 8
- Exhibition dates: March 13 April 4, 2026
- Opening celebration: Friday, March 13 from 4pm-6pm

Please register online before <u>December 20, 2025</u>. If you find you are able to participate after this date, please let us know as soon as you can so we can make any adjustments to the specifics for the show. The specifics (e.g. how to set up the labels, number of pieces each school can enter) regarding each show will be sent to registered participants shortly after the participation deadline.

IMPORTANT: We understand that things do come up so if you sign up to be in the show, but for some reason find that you are later unable to participate, please let us know ASAP so we can tell teachers at participating schools they are able to bring more of their students' artwork.
