### **Elementary Art Show (February 19 – March 12, 2027)**

- Open to grades K to 6 only\*

### **Middle/High School Juried Art Show (March 19 – April 9, 2027)**

This exhibition is open to students in grades 6-12\*. Students in grades 6-9 will be judged as one group, while grades 10-12 will be juried as a separate group. They will be juried (and awarded) separately but will be hung as one cohesive show. *Please note that not all submissions will be accepted.*

*Middle/High School work must be professionally presented and ready to hang.*

Specific information (such as labeling and the number of pieces each school may submit) will be sent to registered participants shortly after the deadline.
